













SECOND CALL FOR PAPERS

YOU ARE INVITED to attend the more important technical meeting on anaerobic digestion and related matters: The 12th World Congress on Anaerobic Digestion (AD12) of the International Water Association (IWA). This meeting, organized by several Mexican universities and research centers jointly with the IWA Specialist Group on Anaerobic Digestion, will be held in Guadalajara, México, from October 31st to November 4th, 2010.

We are expecting more than 600 delegates to AD-12, due to the traditional high scientific and technical level of the congress, but also to tourist attractions that Guadalajara, Jalisco and Mexico have to offer. We look forward meeting the global anaerobic community at Guadalajara, in order to share fruitful discussions and a great time.

THE CONGRESS will focus on the advances, frontiers and applications of anaerobic digestion for a more sustainable planet. The theme of the conference is **Anaerobic Digestion: Water**

and Energy for the World. Consequently, these and other relevant issues will be addressed to promote experience exchange and international cooperation.

AD12 is the ideal forum to present recent advances in the area, either research results or new technologies, considering the global and multidisciplinary audience that will attend. World renowned specialists, as well as representatives from the public and private sectors will be present.

Additionally, a commercial exhibition, where companies can show their latest products, will also take place during the congress. The technical program will integrate invited keynote lectures by recognized specialists on relevant topics, platform and poster presentations, as well as workshops. Technical visits will take place on Friday November 5th.

THE VENUE is Fiesta Americana Hotel, with plenty space for sessions, comfortable and very well located, offering accessible rates for attendees. Guadalajara is the capital city of Jalisco state and is the cradle of tequila and mariachi, two symbols of Mexico. Some tequila factories have installed anaerobic treatment plants, so the visit to the town of Tequila will be a most attractive technical-touristic visit, just 60 km from Guadalajara.

THE ORGANIZERS are research leader institutions in Mexico: Instituto de Ingeniería – Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México (II-UNAM), Universidad de Guadalajara (U de G), Instituto Potosino de Investigación Científica y Tecnológica (IPICYT) and Universidad Autónoma Metropolitana – Iztapalapa (UAM-I). These institutions are deeply involved in anaerobic digestion research. Also, the Inter American Association of Sanitary and Environmental Engineers (AIDIS) will provide secretariat support and diffusion through its member network in the Latin American region. AD12 is supported by the International Water Association and its Anaerobic Digestion Specialist Group.

Four keynote lectures will be given by world renowned experts during each day of the Conference. Confirmed key-note speakers are Professors Perry McCarty (USA), Bruce Rittmann (USA), Herbert Fang (HK, China) and Eugenio Foresti (Brazil).

WORKSHOPS

Workshops will be organized as part of the program. The topics are: Nutrient recovery for anaerobic digestion effluents, Technology innovation /advances for energy production and Anaerobic digestion in the cities of the future. More information will soon be available on the Congress web page.

PAPER SUBMISSION

All contributions accepted for presentation will be included in the congress proceedings.

The review process of technical contributions will be in charge of the Scientific Committee. All submissions and presentations should be in English and must be related to any of the themes of the congress.

There are two options for submission:

- Full paper (6 to 8 pages) for oral presentations. Each oral presentation will take 20 minutes, including 5 minutes for Q&A. Selected papers will be recommended for submission for publication in Water Science and Technology through an independent review process.
- Short paper (2 to 4 pages) for poster presentation. Posters will be grouped according to their topics in different poster sessions. Authors are requested to be available for questions during poster sessions.

Full papers to be considered for oral presentation must be submitted no later than: **April 30th, 2010**. Short papers for poster presentation will be accepted until the **June 15th, 2010**.

All manuscripts should be prepared following the Water Science and Technology guidelines

PAPER ACCEPTANCE AND ALITHOR REGISTRATION



LETTINGA AWARD 2010 - CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The winner of this prestigious award for research on anaerobic digestion will be announced during AD12 congress.
